General Requirements of Fire Department Licenses:

- 1) All license applications shall be submitted 30 days prior to commencing the prescribed activities.
- 2) A separate application, fee, and license shall be required for each hazard listed.
- 3) Application can be made at the Madison Fire Department 325 W. Johnson St. Madison, WI 53703.
- 4) License fees are \$100.00 per license except:
 - Pyrotechnic Special-Effect Materials or Public Display of Fireworks license fee is \$250.00.
- 5) License fees are payable to the **City of Madison**.
- 6) A license is not transferable, and any change in equipment, ownership, use or occupancy of premises shall require a new license.
- 7) An inspection may be required before the issuance of a license.
- 8) Applications shall be acted upon within fifteen (15) business days.
- 9) Licenses shall at all times be prominently displayed on the premises.
- 10) Licenses shall be valid for no more than 1 year. The term of each annual license shall be from July 1 to June 30 of the next succeeding year.
- 11) Complete the instructions on the reverse side of this form.

By completing and signing this license application you acknowledge and agree to comply with Madison General Ordinance Chapter 34, Wisconsin Administrative Codes and the International Fire Code.

Cryogenic Fluid*	IFC 105.6.11, Chapter 32	INSIDE BUILDING: Flammable – More than 1 gallon Inert – 60 gallons Oxidizing – 10 gallons Physical or Health Hazard (Not indicated above) – any amount OUTSIDE BUILDING Flammable – 60 gallons Inert – 500 gallons Oxidizing – 50 gallons Physical or Health Hazard (Not indicated above) – any amount		
Cutting & Welding	IFC 105.6.12, Chapter 26	To conduct cutting or welding operations within the jurisdiction.		
Flammable & Combustible Liquids*	IFC 105.6.17, Chapter 34	Class I liquids in excess of 5 gallons in a building or in excess of 10 gallons outside of a building. To store, handle or use Class II or Class IIIA liquids in excess of 25 gallons in a building or in excess of 60 gallons outside a building.		
Floor Finishing	IFC 105.6.18, Section 1510	Required for floor finishing or surfacing operations exceeding 350 square feet (33 m2) using Class I or Class II liquids.		
HPM Facilities	IFC 105.6.22	To store, handle or use hazardous production materials.		
Magnesium*	IFC 105.6.29, Section 3606	To melt, cast, heat-treat or grind more than 10 pounds (4.54 kg) of magnesium.		
Organic Coating*	IFC 105.6.33, Chapter 22	Any organic-coating manufacturing operation producing more than 1 gallon (4 L) of an organic coating in one day.		
Pyroxylin Plastics	IFC 105.6.37, Chapter 42	Storage or handling of more than 25 pounds (11 kg) of cellulose nitrate (pyroxylin) plastics and for the assembly or manufacture of articles involving pyroxylin plastics.		
Storage of Scrap tires, byproducts	IFC 105.6.42, Chapter 25	To establish, conduct or maintain storage of scrap tires and tire byproducts that exceeds 2,500 cubic feet of total volume of scrap tires and for indoor storage of tires and tire byproducts.		
Wood Products	IFC 105.6.46, Chapter 19	To store chips, hogged material, lumber or plywood in excess of 200 cubic feet (6 m3).
