The SBE Appeals Committee heard an appeal by Norcon Corporation, for Contract 9377, University Avenue Box Repair – 2023, on December 11, 2023.

2. CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING QUASI-JUDICIAL HEARING ITEM
Appeal of the Department of Civil Rights' finding that Century Traffic, LLC's SBE Bid for Contract 9621, 2025 SEMI-PERMANENT EPOXY PAVEMENT MARKINGS, was non-responsible on the basis of:
 1. Contractor has not demonstrated meeting the prescribed goal for this project.
 2. Contract has not demonstrated sufficient good faith effort to meet the prescribed goal for this project.
 3. Contract has failed to submit completed SBE Contact Report(s) as required, thus rendering their SBE Compliance Report incomplete.

Possible Closed Session – The Small Business Enterprises Appeals Committee may meet from time to time in closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats 19.85(1)(g) to confer with legal counsel for the purposes of rendering oral or written advise concerning legal strategy to be adopted by the Committee with respect to litigation it is, or is likely, to become involved in, and may be from time to time in closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. 19.85(1)(a) to deliberate concerning the case that is the subject of the quasi-judicial hearing before The Committee. The Committee may reconvene in open session immediately following any such closed session.
