Hello, Town of Madison Residents

Many Streets Division services will begin operating in your neighborhoods on the day of the attachment, October 31, 2022.

Due to limitations with the technological infrastructure that powers the maps and schedules, you will not be able to look up your collection schedules for your new City of Madison services before the attachment date.

Below covers the information we can provide you with today regarding the upcoming Streets Division services:

Timeline for Trash & Recycling Collection Services for Town of Madison Residents

• Week of October 17, 2022:

One tan cart for trash and one green cart for recycling will be delivered to Town of Madison residents joining the City of Madison. You will be receiving a 95 gallon trash cart and a 65 gallon recycling cart.

Along with the carts, a welcome letter, Recyclopedia, and collection calendar for your home will be delivered.

October 31, 2022:

First collection for Town of Madison for residents with a Monday scheduled pickup day.

Trash & Recycling Collection Calendars

Until the attachment is complete, incoming Town of Madison residents can get their collection schedule from www.cityofmadison.com/TownofMadison. Check the "Brush, Trash & Recycling" section of the "Service Changes" page.

Following the attachment, the collection calendars will be available at www.cityofmadison.com/CollectionSchedule.

Large Item Collection

Bulky items like mattresses, furniture, and certain appliances are collected after residents submit a work order. Work orders can be completed at www.cityofmadison.com/LargeItemWorkOrder

You will be able to submit the work order to begin schedule large item pickup after the attachment date.

Fall Leaf & Yard Waste Collection

Residents who live in the areas shaded green on the attached map should have their yard waste and leaves out for pickup on October 30, 2022. City crews will be providing yard waste pickup during the work week following Sunday, October 30, 2022.

Other neighborhoods from the Town of Madison will have yard waste collection later in the year.

Once the attachment is complete, you will be able to find when to place yard waste out for pickup by the City of Madison at www.cityofmadison.com/YardWaste.

Enter your address into the form on the website, and it will tell you the dates when to set out leaves and yard waste for pickup.

Brush Collection

The City of Madison's brush collection will have ended by the time the attachment occurs. No regular curbside brush collection will happen for the Town of Madison residents until the spring of 2023.

• Christmas Tree Collection

After the New Year's holiday, there are two collection rounds to collect Christmas trees. This is considered a separate collection operation than the collection of trimmed branches and other brush.

Winter Services & Alternate Side Parking

All information about the City of Madison plowing and salting strategies can be found at www.cityofmadison.com/Winter.

It is strongly recommended that you sign up to be part of the Snow Plow Update and Snow Emergency winter email lists. Each time plows are dispatched in response to a storm, an email is sent explaining the operations and what to expect on the roadways.

You can also sign up to receive text alerts for Declared Snow Emergencies.

Madison alternate side parking rules begin enforcement at 1:00am on November 15, 2022. There is a dedicated website to guide you what side of the street to park. You can also sign up for daily text alerts. Enforcement of winter parking rules is handled by Madison parking enforcement officers, which are not part of the Streets Division.
