

Opening Task I ExpressVote

Federal law requires that the ExpressVote be set up at every polling place. Set it up so that people standing in line cannot look at the touchscreen and see how someone is voting. Provide enough space (turning radius of 5 feet b for voters in mobility devices.

Place the ExpressVote on a table or voting booth at least 30 inches wide sure the table is 28 to 34 inches high with a knee clearance of 19 inches a measuring tape in the supply kit.



1. Determine best location

Use the guidelines above to find a spot com voters using a mobility device. Place a chair for voters without mobility devices who will u Express/Vote.

Remove from Case

Remove the ExpressVote from its black carrying case. Remove the power cord and headphones from the pocket on the outside of the carrying case. Plug the small circular end of the power cord into the port on the back of the ExpressVote (flat side up). Plug the power cord into the wall. Tilt the machine back onto its metal support legs.

2. Power Up

Unlock the security access door on the left side of the machine using the barrel key. Set the power switch to On. Verify that the mode switch in this security access compartment is set to Voter. The screen will say that the machine is starting up.

Quick Guide to Processing Absentee Ballots

Revised 3/2024

Two officials should be involved any time we are dealing with voted ballots. When opening a package of absentees, write the seal number and time on the Absentee Diary of Events.

1. Sort absentee envelopes

a) Check the ward number to make sure the ballots are at the right polling place.

The label on each envelopes lists the ward number. If a ballot war the wrong polling place, call the Clerk's Office at (608) 266-4220. your Absentee Diary of Events.



- b) Make sure envelopes are sealed with no evidence of tampering envelope is not sealed or there is evidence of tampering, reject the Do not assign a voter slip number. Do not open the envelope. Set rejection.
 - Some voters tape envelopes closed before placing them in that is okay.
 - ✓ If an envelope is not completely sealed, determine whether shave tampered with the ballot.
- c) Check certificates for voter and witness signatures. Each cer have the signature (or mark) of the voter and the voter's witness. these signatures is missing, reject the absentee. Do not assign a number. Do not open the envelope. Set aside for rejection.
 - ✓ Signatures do not need to be legible.

Closing Task D

Reconcile Poll Lists

(Ideally, poll workers will have completed most of this during the day.)

- □ Switch seats so you are not checking your own work.
- ☐ Line up the corresponding pages of the poll book. Visually compare shapes on each page to find anything that does not match.
- □ Fix any differences that you can figure out.
- → If a voter number is missing from one poll book, determine whether that was a poll worker error. If so, fill in the missing number.
- → If a voter number is missing an A to say it was an absentee voter, add the A to the voter number.
- □ Note on the incident log if there are differences you cannot figure out.
- → If a voter number was given to a different person in each poll book, note that on the incident log.
- If voter signatures are not all in one poll book, document discrepancies on the incident log.
- If second and third ballots were not noted on the poll books, do so now. Use the green second ballot log that was used at the ballot table.
- Include the supplemental lists in your review.



- Provisional ballots of voters unable to provide the Wisconsin driver license or state identification card number required by Wis. Stat. § 6.55(2)(a)1., and/or unable to provide an acceptable form of photo identification pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 6.79 (2)(a), shall be kept in their certificate envelopes.
- These ballots may not be counted, unless the voter returns with the required Wisconsin driver license or state identification card number and/or an acceptable form of photo identification before the polls close.
- The names of provisional voters are assigned a serial number (PVW_) that is recorded on the registration list, the back of the ballot, the Provisional Ballot Cartificate Envelope (EL-123), the Provisional Ballot Reporting Form (EL-123r), the EL-123is "Provisional Voting Information Sheet" for the elector and listed on the Inspectors' Statement (EL-104).
- The back of the ballot should be marked "Section 6.97," voted by the elector, placed in the completed provisional ballot certificate envelope and returned to the election inspectors.
- The inspectors make a notation (including the PV#) that the voter was issued a provisional ballot on the inspectors' Statement (EL-104).
- The completed provisional ballot certificate envelopes containing the voted ballots are placed in this carrier envelope. This certier envelope and any other provisional ballot carrier envelopes must also be placed in a separate ballot bag, secured with a temper-evident seal and labeled with "Provisional Ballots."

Municipal Clerks


Powder in Envelope

- Do not sniff, touch, taste, or inspect



Evacuation

- Everyone within 15-30 feet of envelope stays in room
- Otherwise, evacuate room
- Close doors
- Wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water
- Document who had checked in but couldn't vote



Evacuation

- Try to keep everyone who evacuated together until Emergency Responders arrive
- Station a poll worker outside each entrance or exit for voting room until Emergency Responders arrive
- Ask facility to turn off HVAC, if possible


