

Petitioner Anthony Nino Amato alleges and shows to the City of Madison Clerk:

1. That Petitioner was a candidate for the office of Alder District 19, City of Madison in an election held on April 1, 2025; and
2. That Petitioner is informed and believes that a series of mistakes have been made, including questionable actions made by electors in counting votes in one or more of the wards in District 19 and in the return of votes cast for the office of Alder District 19, City of Madison.
3. That according to Wis. Stat. 9.01(1)(a) 5.b., because the difference in the number of votes cast for each candidate is less than 1%, the petitioner is entitled to a recount of all the votes in all the wards.
4. That Petitioner is an aggrieved party.

Wherefore: Petitioner requests a recount of all six wards in District 19, City of Madison by individual ballot. Dated this 7th day of April, 2025.
