- Remove or cover any valuables left in your vehicle
- Do not leave firearms in your vehicle
- Remember to close overhead garage doors even when you are home
- Know the login information for any vehicle tracking system for your vehicles
- Notify police if you see unusual activity such as suspicious people or vehicles. Call 911 if it is happening now.
