




Project Location

Future Paths




Bicycle Network – West Towne Path Corridor

- Connect Far-Westside Neighborhoods to Downtown Madison
- ➤ Safe, Continuous Multi-Use Path for All Ages & Abilities

- ➤ Consistent with Adopted City Policies
 - ➤ Vision Zero
 - ➤ Madison Bike-Ped Comprehensive Plans
- ➤ Receiving Funding through the Federal Transportation Alternative Program (TAP)
 - > Facilitated by Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT)
 - **≻**Limited Funds
 - >4(f) Resources Identified







West Towne Path - Phase 2a: Proposed Design

- ➤ 0.3-mile-long path extension, parallel to W Beltline Hwy
- ➤ Path partially built on easement through current Zor Shrine Development
- ➤ Path Connection to Zor Shrine Place cul-de-sac
- ➤ No anticipated impacts to W Beltline Hwy, guardrail to remain
- ➤ Retaining Wall between Path and Beltline likely needed
- Fence installed between path and guardrail
- **→** Path Lighting
