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Construction Fact and Details Sheet: LAKE STREET SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT - 2024

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Construction Schedule: Work is scheduled to begin June 24, 2024 and be completed


By August 30, 2024. The work includes replacement of the sanitary sewer main from south of University Avenue up to the State Street Garage project at 415 N. Lake Street.

Normal work times for public works projects are from 7:00am to 7:00pm. However, to allow the contractor some additional time to quickly complete the project, the Board of Public Works and the Common Council have approved the allowable work hours for this project to be 7:00am to 11:00pm. Although the hours were extended, the Contractor currently does not plan to work past normal working hours. If that should change as the project moves along, updates on days when work will extend past the normal working hours will be posted to the City project website. There may be times when emergencies come up and notification isn't possible but these should be limited.

The estimated limits of the phasing are shown on the map.

Construction will begin at the University Avenue intersection and the Contractor will work towards the north. It is expected that the Contractor will be done and out of University Avenue by July 29, 2024.

Traffic Impacts: There will be major traffic impacts associated with this project. For Phase 1 of this project, which is the crossing of University Ave, lanes of travel will be restricted along University Avenue. Northbound traffic along N. Lake Street throughout the project limits will be restricted or not allowed. Phase 2 of the project, will be when the Contractor is out of University Avenue and working within N. Lake Street north of University Avenue. With this phase, southbound traffic will be maintained at all times with northbound traffic being restricted.

Through both phases, access to all businesses and University driveways will be maintained at most times. There may be times when the sewer is being installed directly in front of a driveway where the access would be cut off. If driveway access is to be prevented, the Contractor shall provide 48 hours notice.

Water Shut-offs: There are no planned water shut-offs. Emergency shut-offs are possible if existing main is damaged during construction. Affected properties will be notified as soon as possible.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection to continue during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. We ask that you place your carts at the street the evening prior to or at the very latest 6:00 a.m. the morning of your scheduled refuse/recycling day.

Project Details – Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: The City will replace the existing sewer main with 15" cast iron pipe with a new 24" PVC pipe through the project limits. All laterals will be reconnected to the new main but no lateral pipe will be replaced.

Water Main: The City will not replace the water main with the project.

Storm Sewer: The City will replace and improve the storm sewer system in the street and at intersections.

Street: The City will replace all of the concrete pavement and asphalt pavement that is disturbed due to the sanitary sewer installation. Sidewalks and drive aprons are not planned to be impacted.

Bus Pads: Bus pads will not be installed with the project.

Street Lights: There are no proposed changes to street lighting within the project limits.

Traffic Signals: There are no proposed changes to the traffic signal at the corner of Atwood Avenue and Hudson Avenue.

Trees: There are no tree impacts associated with this project.
