We have seen all around improvement in 2023, offering more classes and having a larger impact than in the previous year.

Courses Overview:

- 103 total course sessions
 - o 74 sessions were facilitated by City Employee's (72%)
 - o 29 sessions were facilitated Third-Party Contractors (28%)
- 53 sessions had 18 or more attendees (51%)
- 8 different departments participated as Learning Partners
- The most common way registrants heard about our courses was via our weekly emails to City of Madison addresses (47%)

Additional Interesting Data:

• Based on registrant reported primary workplace location(s), the data shows that our services and offerings reflect the current (hybrid) state of the workforce.

- Tenure:
 - The tenure of registrants in 2023 peaks at employees who are in their first two-years of employment with the City.
 - There is another small increase of registrations for employees who have been with the city for 11-20 years.
