WHEREAS, the Committee on Community Gardens received an anonymous donation for \$10,000 in November, 1999, to be used to create gardens;

WHEREAS, a total of \$4,304 has been paid out as follows:

November 29, 2001 – Soils and Engineering	\$2,404
December 30, 2001 – UW Madison – December '01 Work Study	\$360
June 30, 2002 – UW Madison – April '02 Work Study	\$240
March 4, 2002 – Soils and Engineering	\$1,300

WHEREAS, the Committee on Community Gardens has created a separate garden fund and has housed it at the Madison Community Foundation;

WHEREAS, a committee of gardeners review grants and allocates funds for new garden projects;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Community Gardens has voted to move this funds balance to the account at the Madison Community Foundation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the balance of this account be moved to the account at the Madison Community Foundation.
