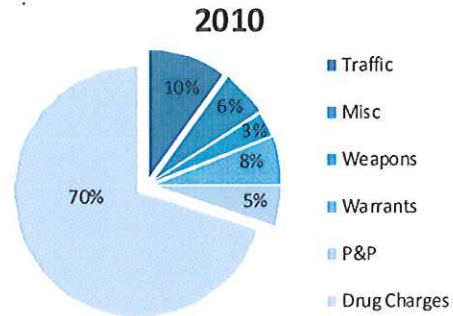

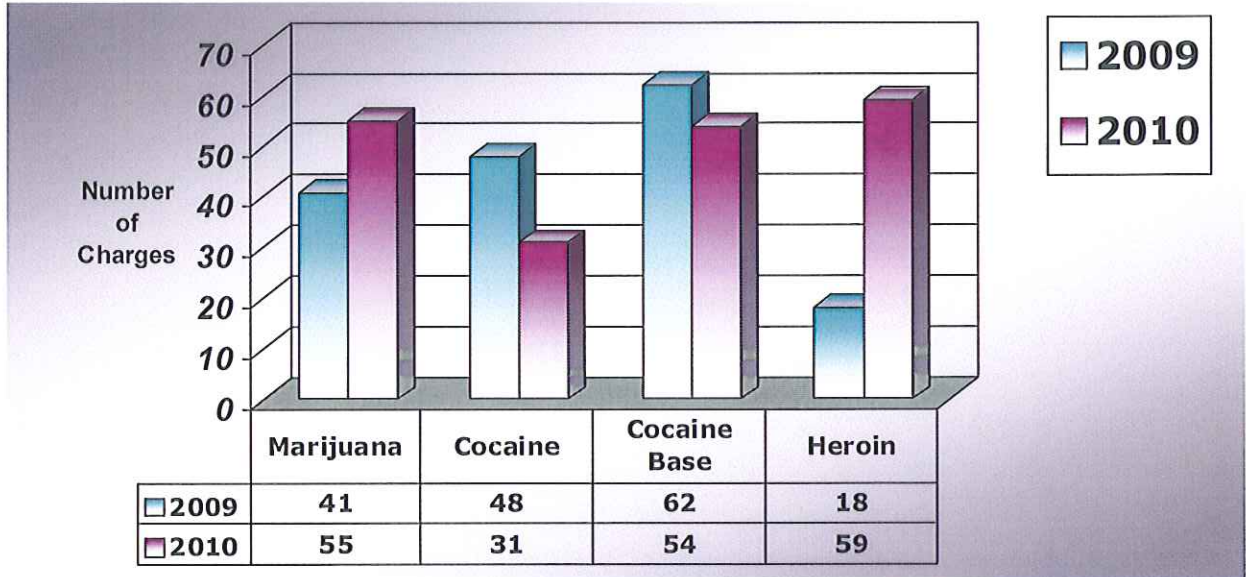

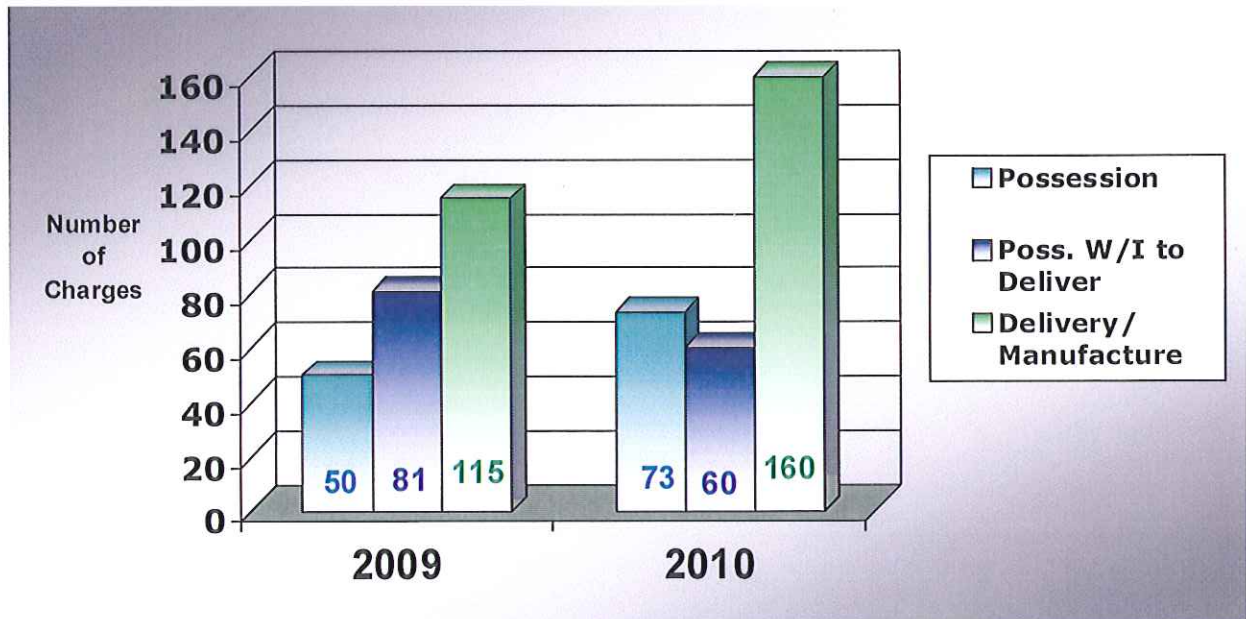

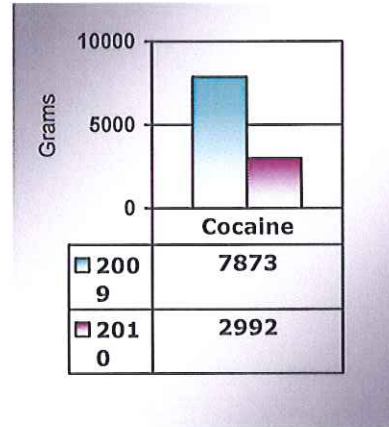
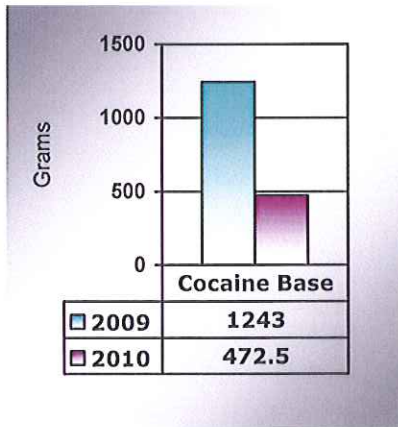
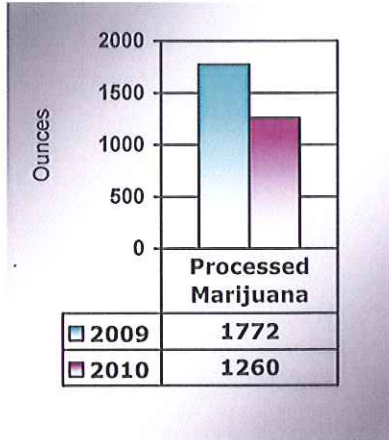
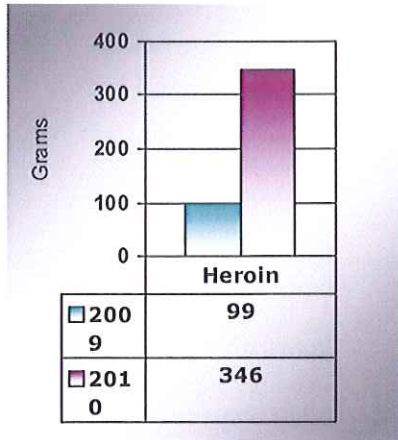
## Drug Charges Broken Down By Type of Drug Involved



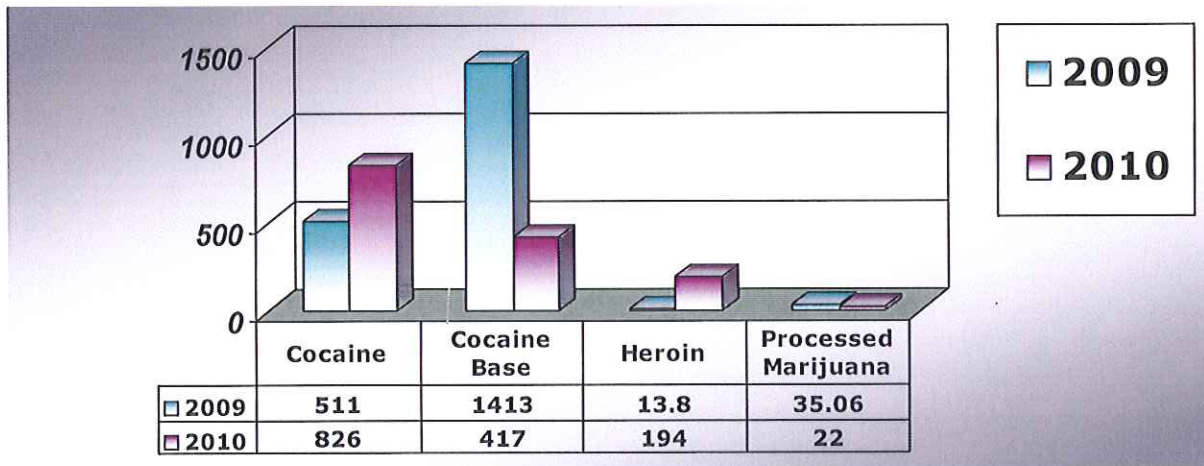
## Drug Charges Broken Down by Type of Charge

## 2010 Marijuana Plant Seizures

In CY 2010, the Dane County Narcotics and Gang Task Force and surrounding agencies responded to and dismantled a total of **13** indoor marijuana grows resulting in **1022** plants taken as evidence or destroyed, **12** outdoor grows resulting in **980** plants taken as evidence or destroyed and **1** outdoor grow of non cultivated plants with **40** plants that were destroyed.
