END OF YEAR 2024 ANNUAL REPORT

DCNTF Mission Statement.

The Dane County Narcotics Task Force (DCNTF) is comprised of women and men from the City of Madison Police Department, Dane County Sheriff's Office, and the UW-Madison Police Department. Additionally, all Law Enforcement agencies in Dane County have the authority to send personnel to work with the DCNTF on shorter assignments as their own staffing allows. The mission of the DCNTF is to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking organizations within the Dane County area. The DCNTF also collaborates with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies in an effort to combat larger drug trafficking organizations.

The DCNTF continues to focus on disrupting and dismantling drug trafficking organizations and providing education to the public on the current trends and danger of drugs. The DCNTF had several new focuses in the year of 2024 as well. This included the partnering in the Gun Violence Reduction Initiative as well as assisting the City of Madison PD in the Strategic Goals.

The DCNTF coordinated the national drug take back events in Dane County. This included staffing 9 locations for drug take backs. We collaborated with WI DOJ, UW School of Pharmacy, Oak Wood Village and Safe Communities Madison-Dane County. In total 35 locations throughout Dane County participated in the drug take back in the spring and fall of 2024. In total 6,890 pounds of unused drugs were taken back from Dane County. The State of WI was the number one state in the nation for drug take back in 2024.

The DCNTF also conducted several community outreach events. These information and educational opportunities allowed DCNTF personnel to connect with community members. This included the partnering with the State of WI Medical Examiners conference and presenting on Overdose Death Investigations.

Another focus of the DCNTF was violent crimes associated with narcotics trafficking. The DCNTF was part of the US Attorney's Office of the Western Districts violent crime initiative. This focus included regular meetings with participating local agencies and federal partners. The DCNTF focused on the successful prosecution of violent offenders involved in narcotics trafficking. This collaboration involved the DCNTF, Madison PD's Violent Crimes Unit, ATF, and the US Attorney's Office. The DCNTF seized 53 weapons in 2024 and issued 52 weapons charges.

While enforcement is a critical component of combating illegal drugs and the correlating criminal activity, we recognize that this is only one part of the community effort that is necessary to reduce drug trafficking and drug dependency. We will continue to partner with those both inside and outside of LE as we combat this health and public safety

issue.

The important work of the DCNTF is driven in large part by the drug tips and community complaints we receive from the public. Tips can be sent anonymously to Madison Area Crime Stoppers by calling 608-266-6014, or by visiting P3TIPS.com



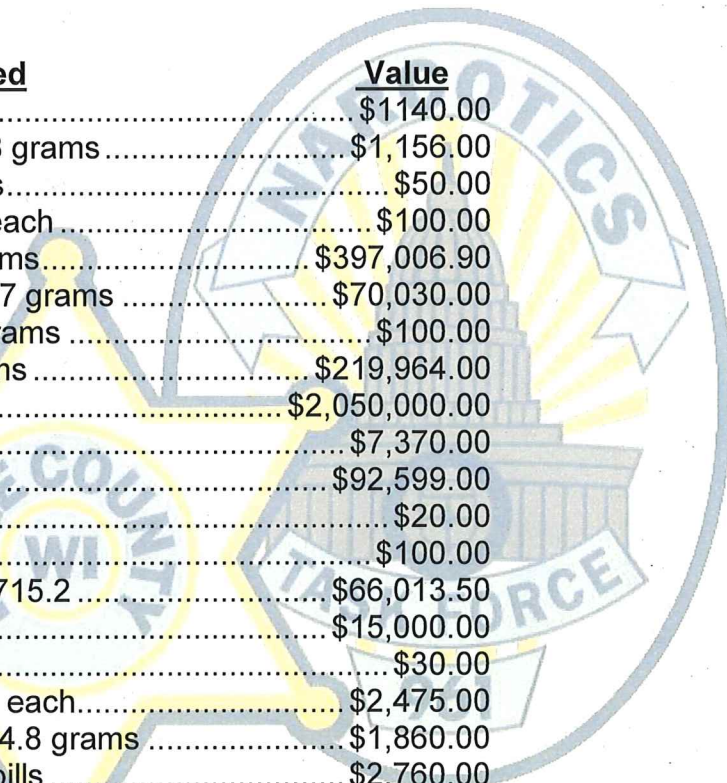
