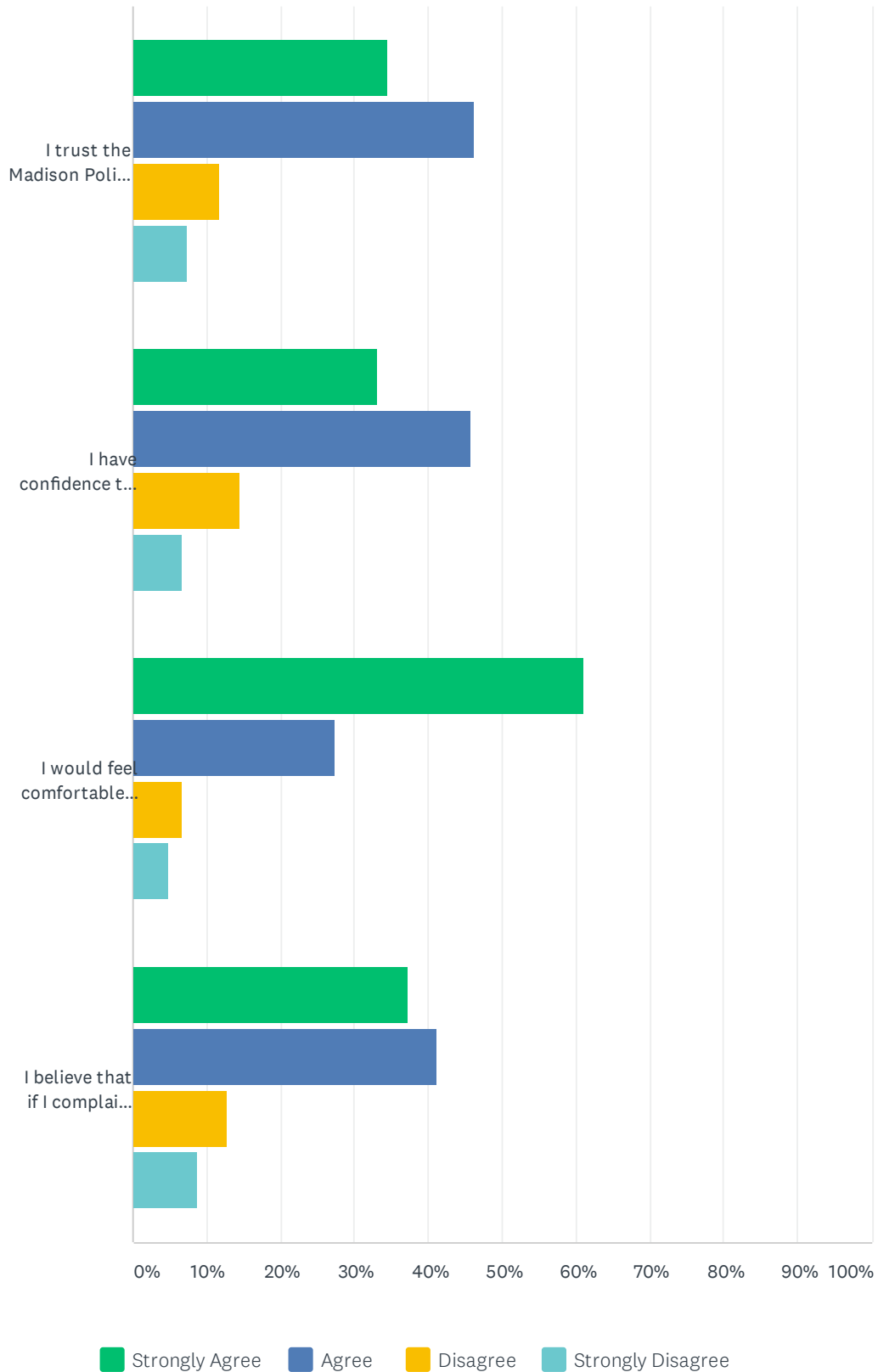

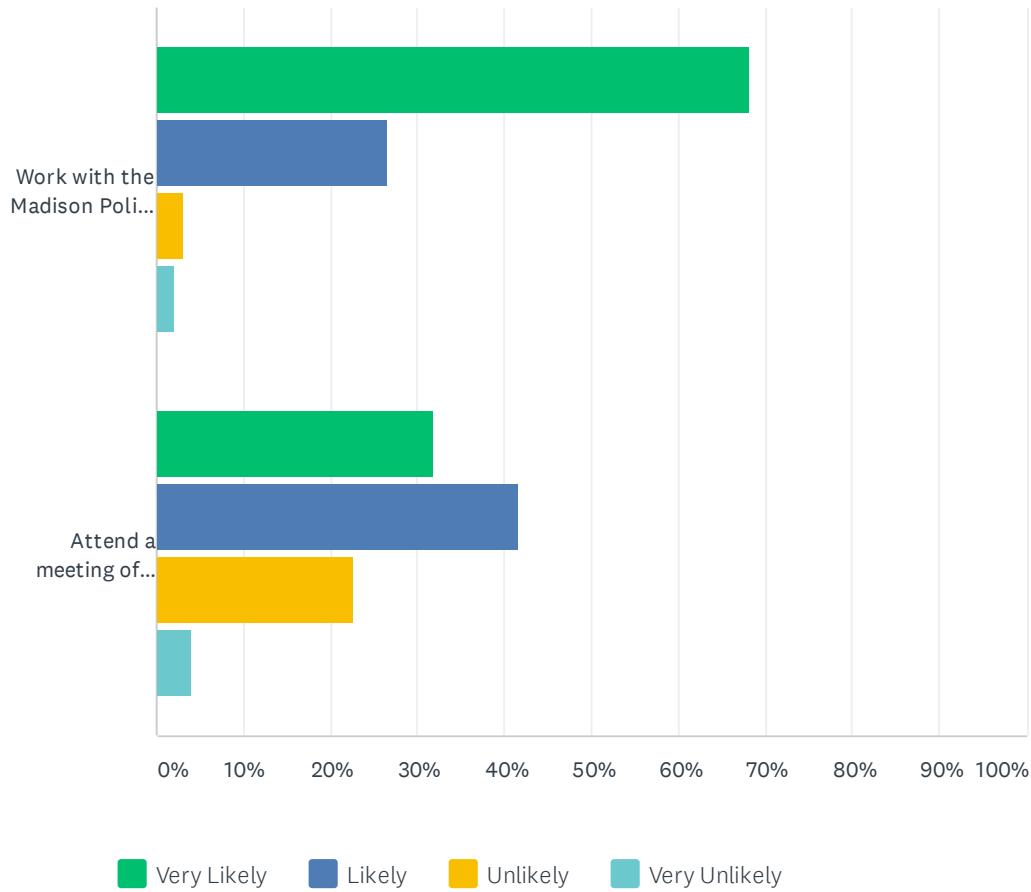

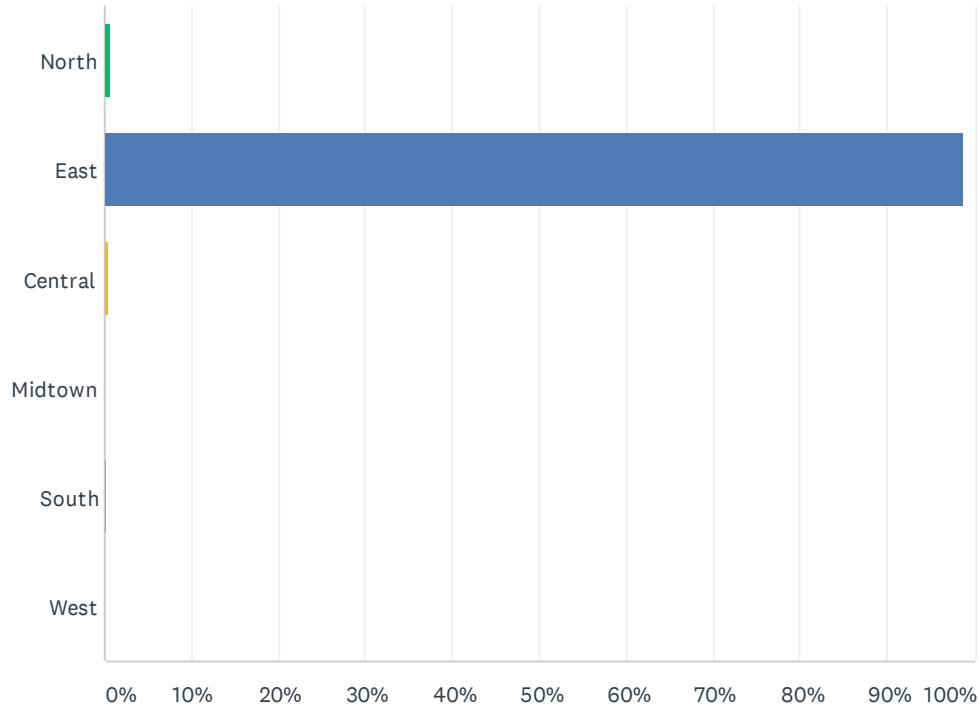

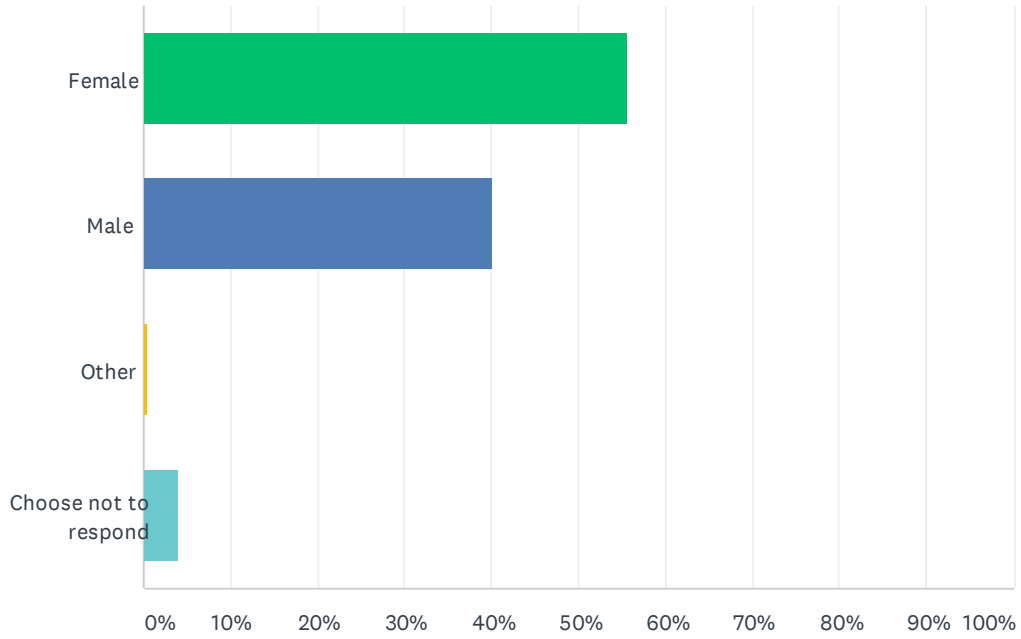

Q8 What gender do you identify as?

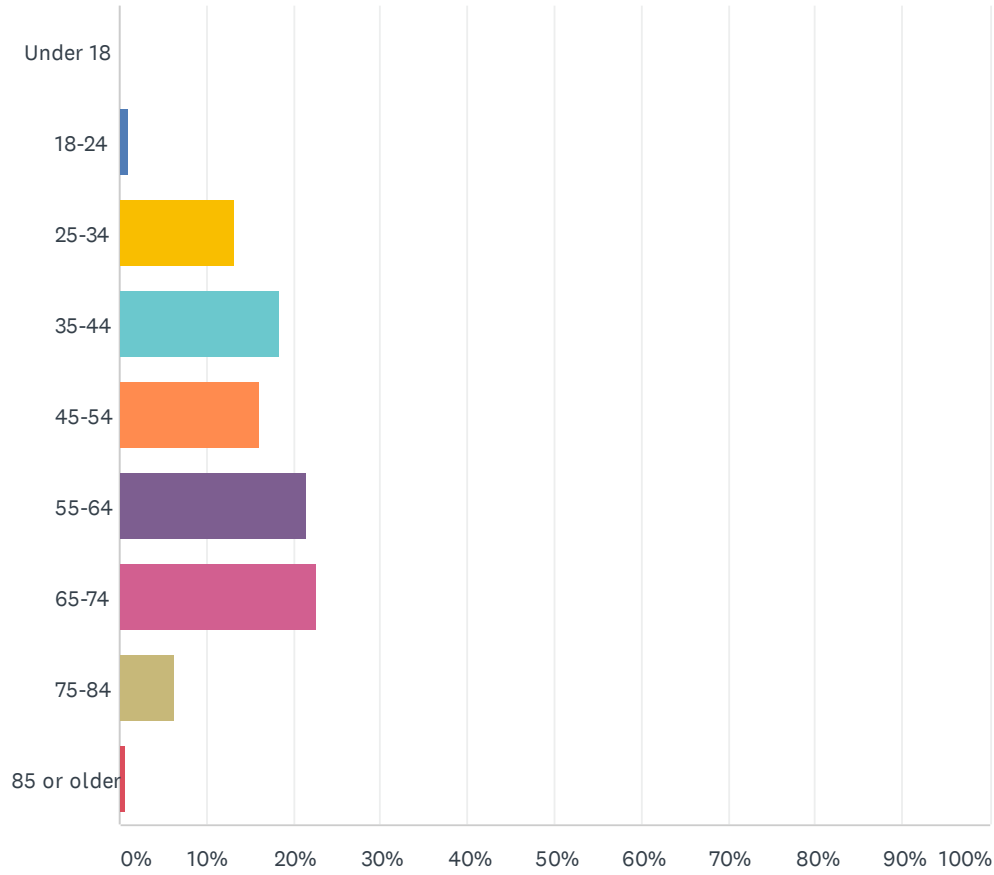

Q9 How old are you?

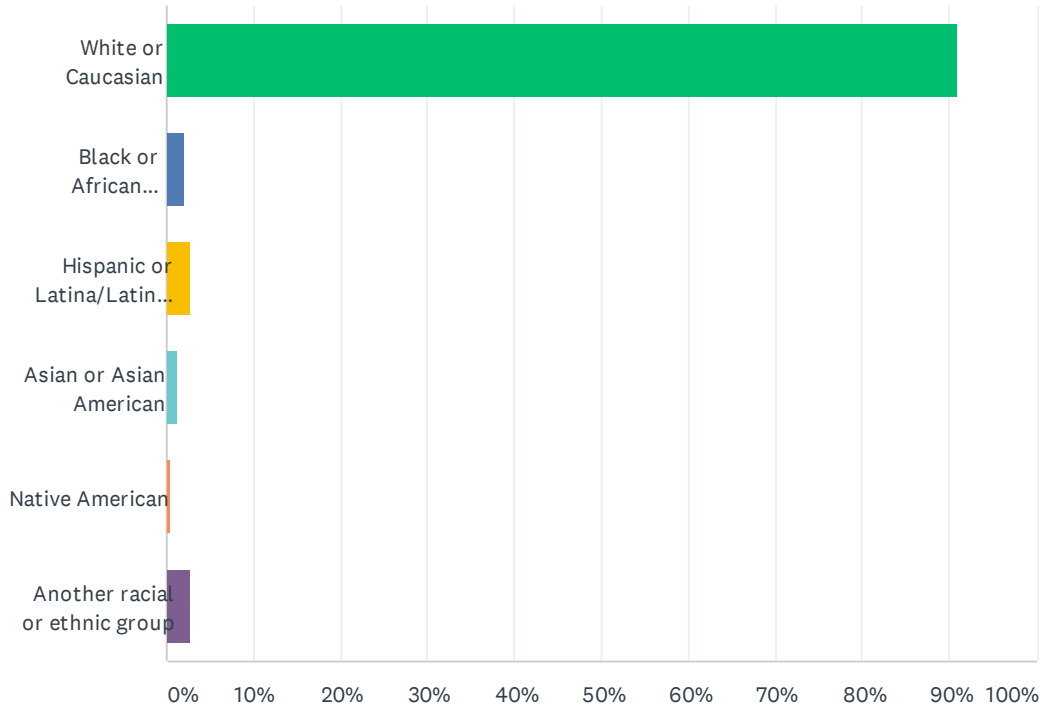

Q10 What is your race?

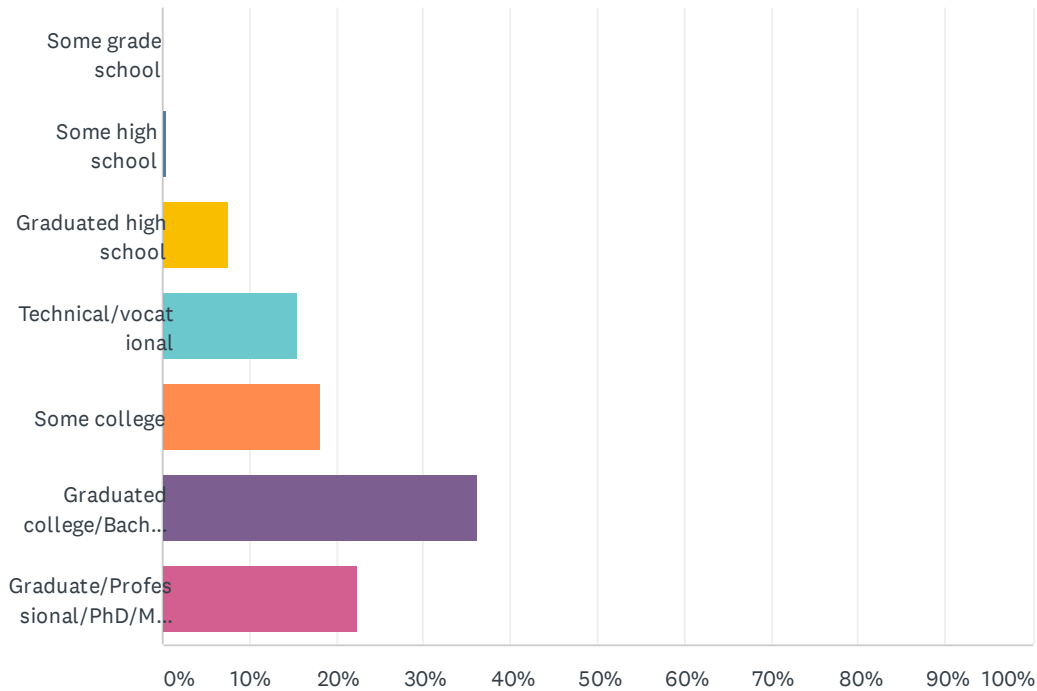

Q11 What is the highest level of education you have achieved?

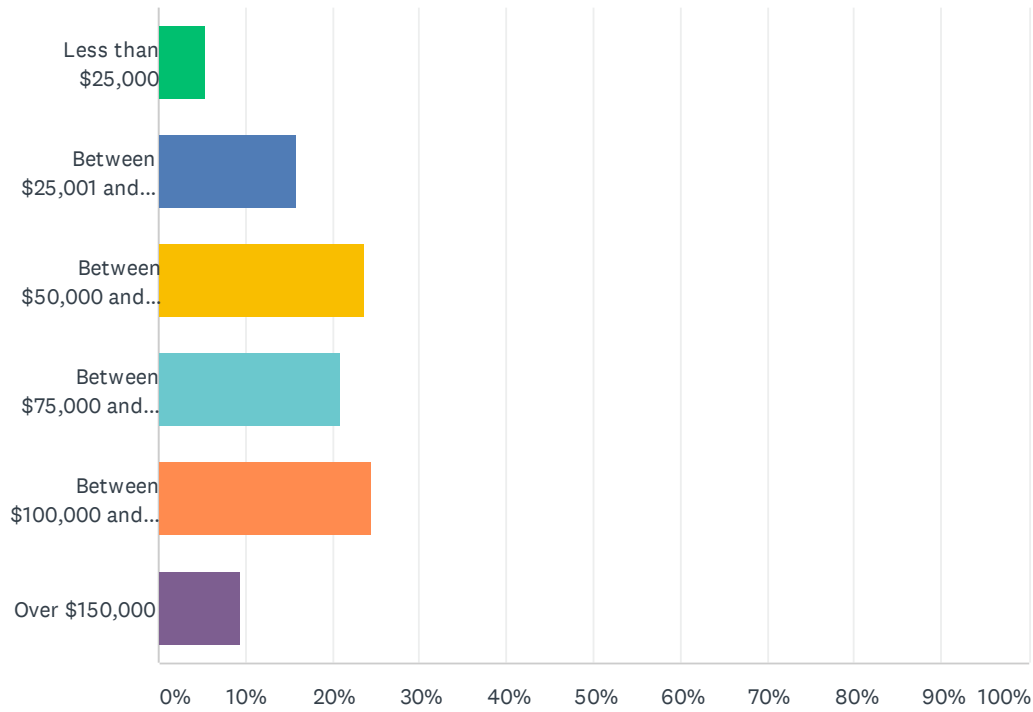
