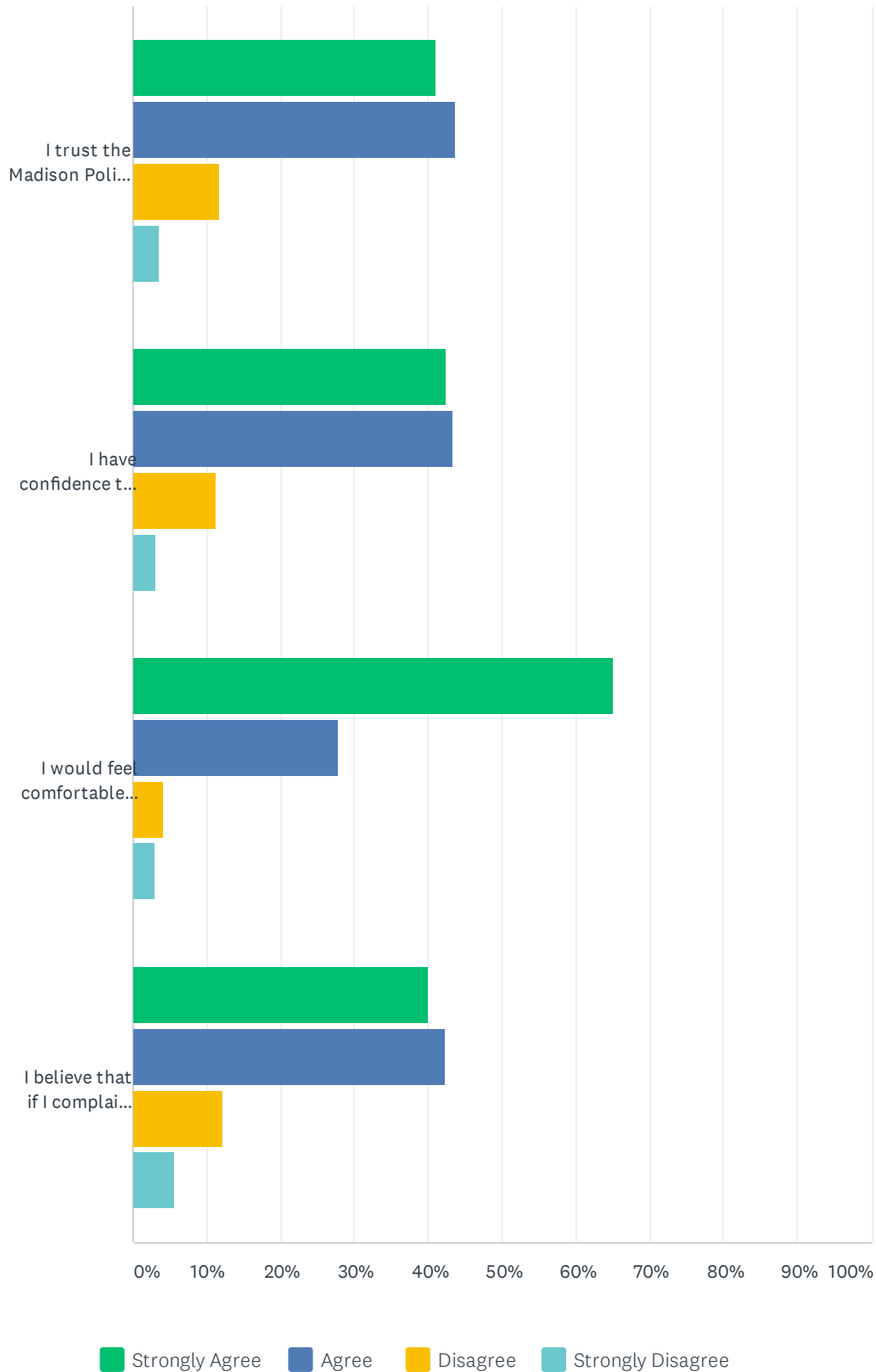

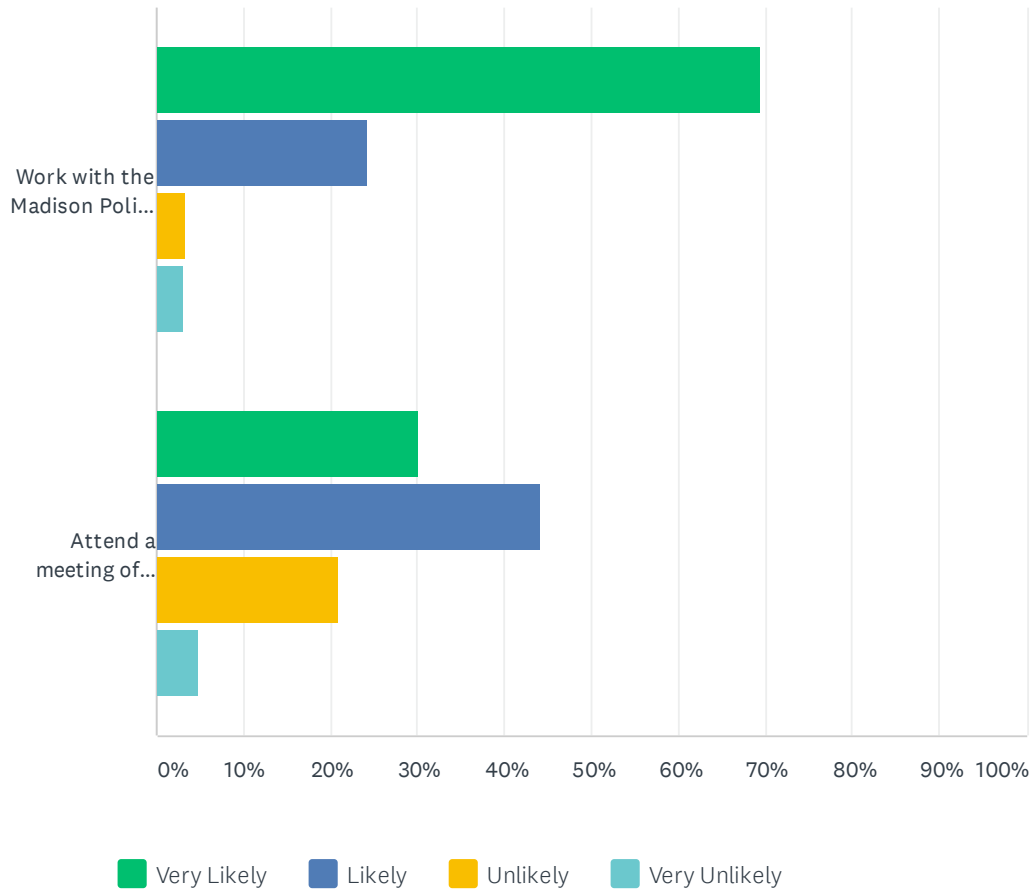

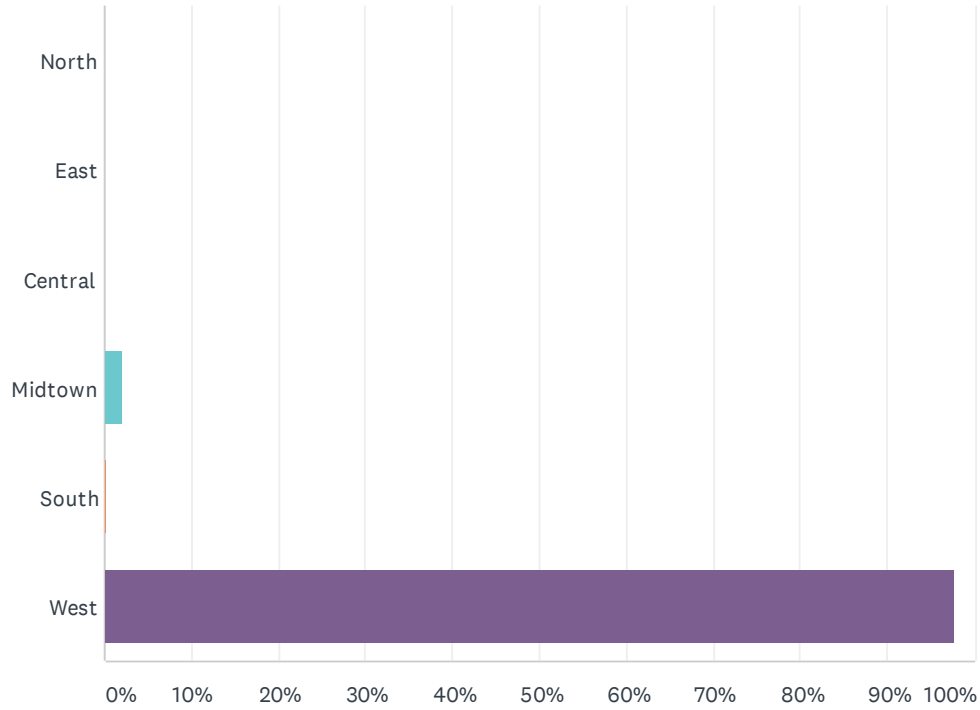

### Q7 What neighborhood (Police District) do you reside in?

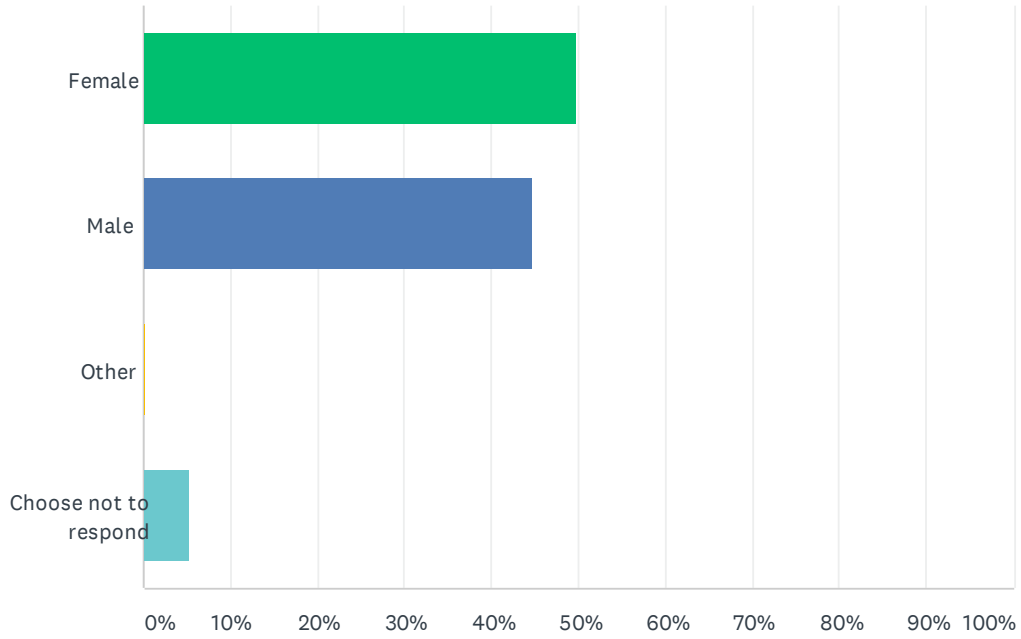

### Q8 What gender do you identify as?

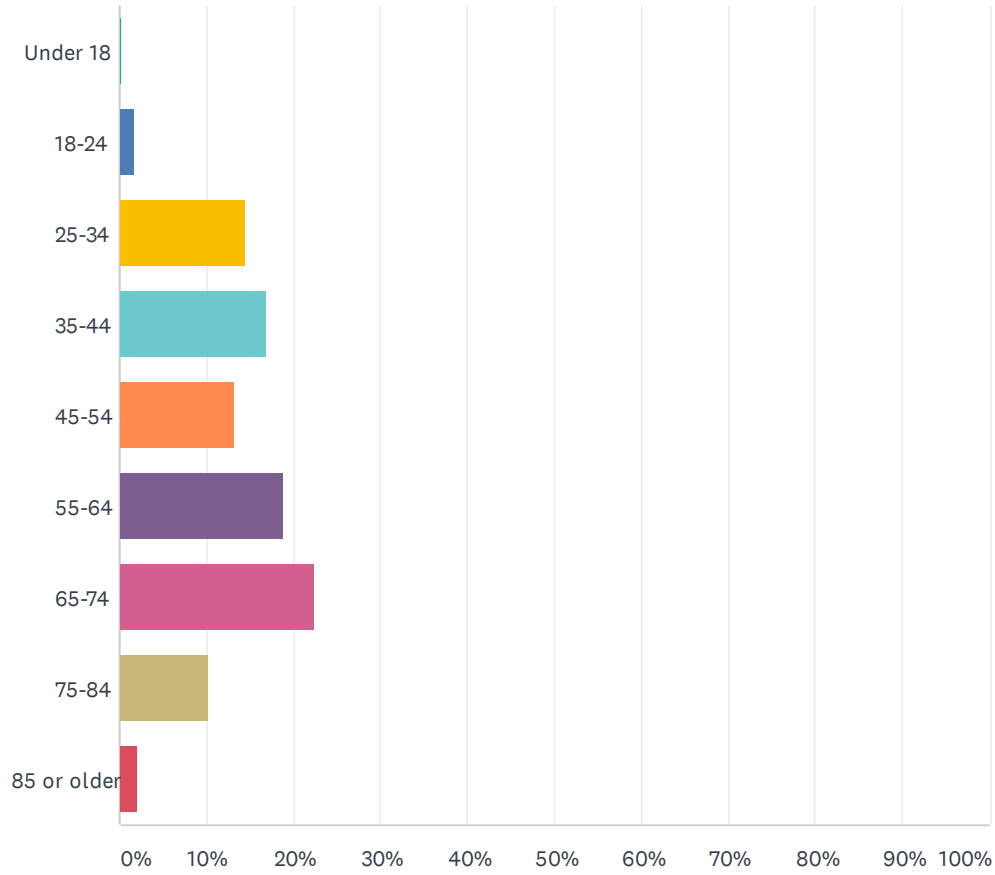

### Q9 How old are you?

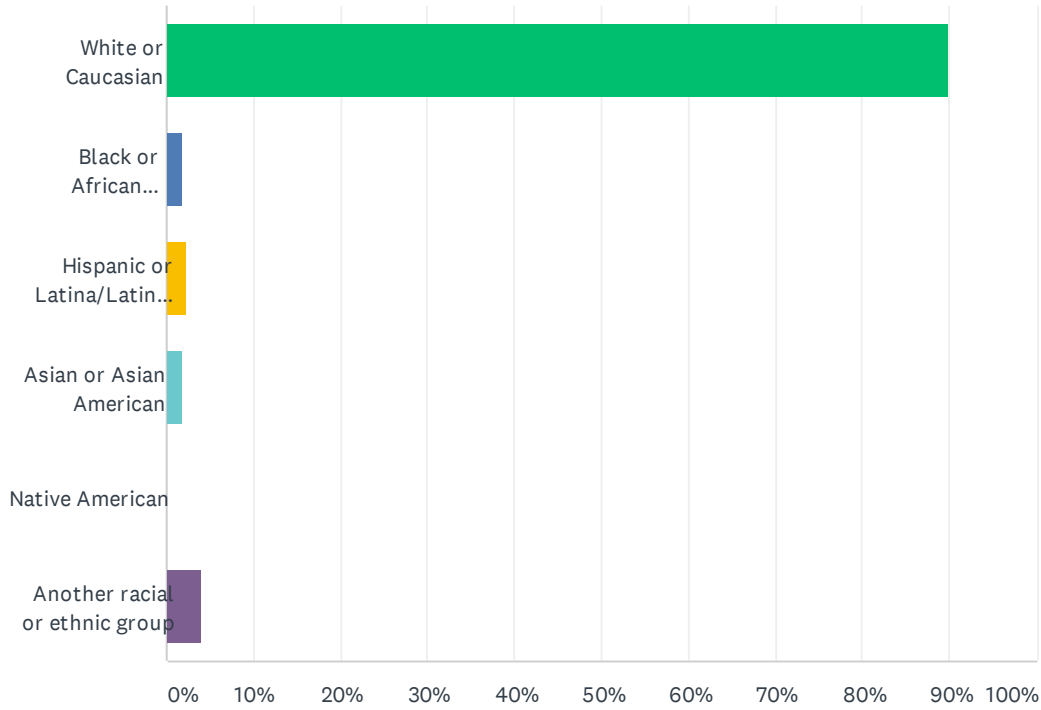

### Q10 What is your race?

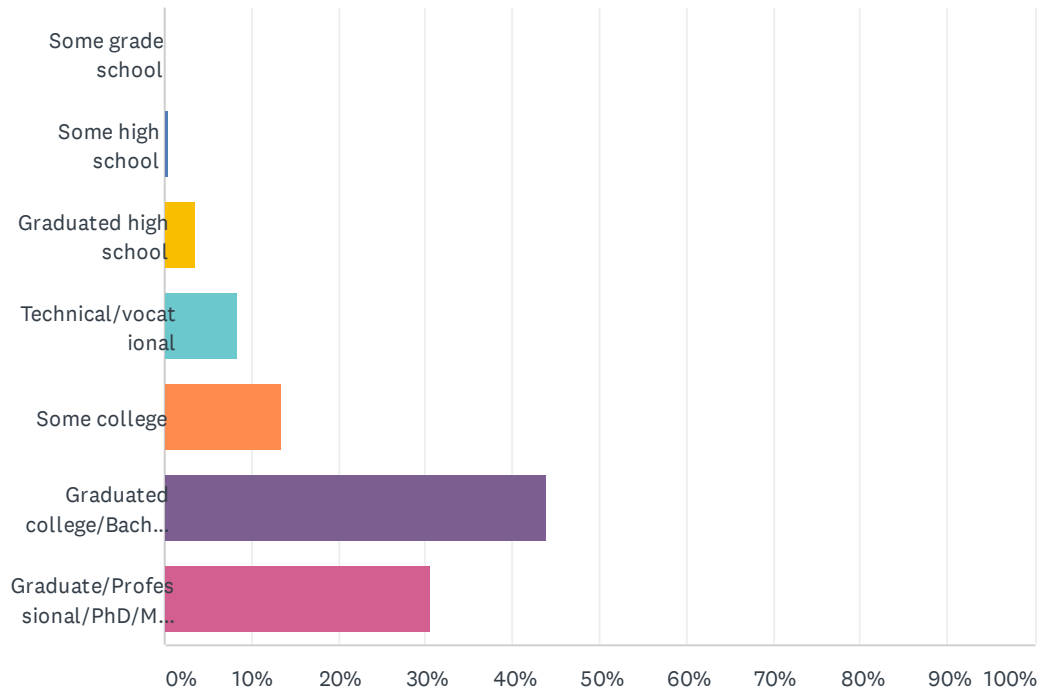

# Q11 What is the highest level of education you have achieved?

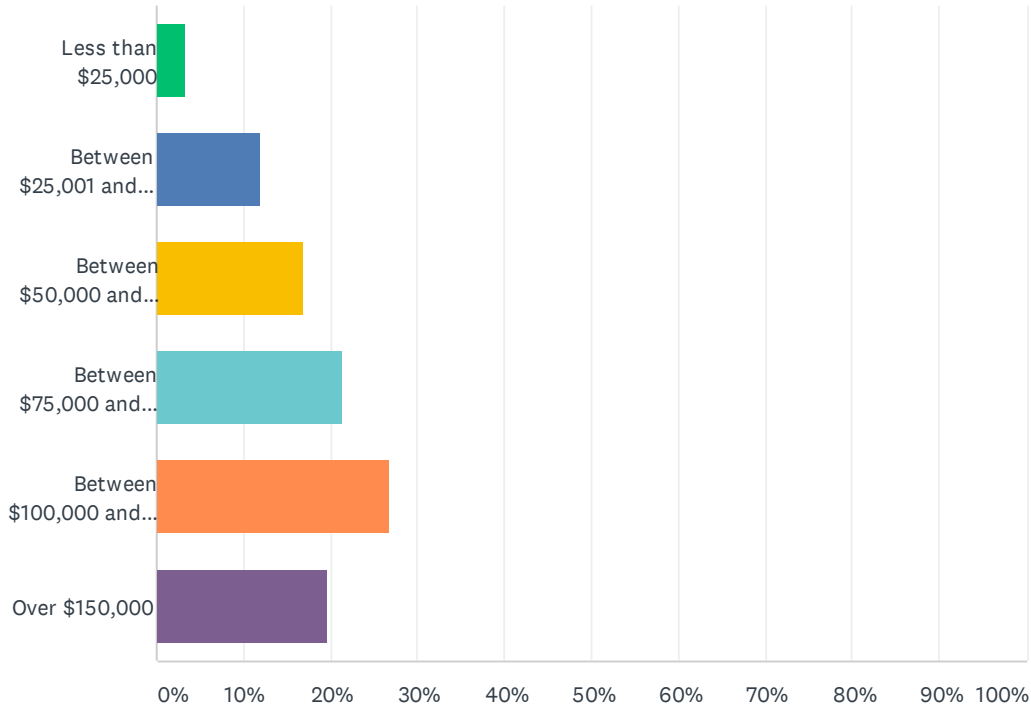
